
The Tigernut

Tigernuts Flour

Tigernuts Oil

All the Tigernut quality concentred into an oil.

Its strong and intense flavour, being nut oil, enhances its attracting power.

Highly recommended for boilies and the preparation of; this oil has almost the same properties as the Tigernut Extract can offer, but in a more intense form. The Tigernut oil is not hydro soluble so it concentrates all its attracting power in the boilie.

Mix recommended dose 15-30 ml./Kg.







Tigernuts Extract (Tigernuts Milk)

Tigernut milk is probably the most typical and traditional drink in around Valencia, and also one of the best baits available for Carp Fishing.

Tigernuts Extract makes an extremely sweet milk containing over a 22% of natural sugars and 30% of fats, allowing the use of this product in many different ways for Carp Fishing purposes.

It can be used directly on the lake as an initial attraction, creating a white cloud that once diluted into the water, the carp however far away they are from your fishing spot, they will come.

It's a perfect product for getting carp to your spot, and directly to your hook.

Perfect for using with PVA bags, as the extract does not dilute this kind of bag, it will only dilute with water contact, where the product will hit with all of its effectiveness.

Highly recommended for the preparation of boilies due to its sticky texture we can reduce the use of eggs in the mixes, and we will get the recommended consistency for the boilie with a high sugar concentration.







Other Particles:

Hemp

Hemp is a little black seed approximately 5 mm length. It requires a previous preparation and there are several ways to do it, depending on the angler's choice

Giant Maize

Just like we previously explained, it is very important to cook the grains properly before using them as bait, because a non correctly cooked grain or a raw one could be especially harmful to the carps. Maize is one of the products which requires the most rigorous preparation, but then it becomes probably one of the most effective baits. This kind of maize is not a genetically modified product, but comes from the Andin region of Peru and its size can be from 18mm up to 24mm.

Beans

A grain specially recommended for fishing due to its large size and to its fantastic properties, very appreciated by the carp. Its size can be from $21\ mm$ up to $26\ mm$

Chickpeas

Just like the maize, chickpea's are one of the grains (not nuts) most appreciated by anglers. It is a perfect bait with which we can start fishing from the ground up, but we have to be carefully with it because it is a grain that attracts some other fish like tench. Its size is about 10 mm.

Peanuts

Peanuts are a legume that are very much valued for human consumption. Its size can be from 18 mm up to 20 mm, and it is a product prone to decay if it is not of the best quality, so it is very important to get a product with human consumption quality, like the one's offered by our company, in order to avoid it to become indigestible for carps.

Lupin

Lupins were very known in the ancient World, and we are now talking about a very useful grain these days, depending on the situation. It is perfect to bait lakes and very valid to use as hook bait. After being soaked for some time its natural sour flavour disappears.

Mapple Peas

Just like the maize or chickpeas, maple peas make an instant bait. One of the most usual mistakes is to use too many grains for fishing, which limites the catches. Probably this is the reason why the maple peas have been forgotten by anglers, but even like this, they are still an excellent grain. It's size is about 7mm diameter.





Prepared products ready-to-use

Particles are probably one of the most effective baits used for Carp Fishing. Also these are the products with the least environmental impact on our fishing waters.

Do it yourself

The main part of particles and grains used for Carp Fishing require a previous preparation, specially Tigernuts, to reach its optimal point of use

For Tigernut preparation we must follow these steps:.



- (1) We must soak the Tigernuts in water to recuperate its natural moisture level, softening a little their hard skin. We have to cover the Tigernut with enough water because they absorb a large amount of water.
- (2) Recommended soaking time is 36 hours.





- (3) Next, we add some more water into the receptacle and then we pour it all into a pot to start the boiling process, which depends on the type of receptacle. It is usual to add some sugar during the cooking process to boost the Tigernut flavour and to get a quicker fermentation.
- (4) Recommended cooking time in a pressure cooker is 45 minutes.





(5) Once boiled, let the Tigernuts cool down in the water where they have been cooked, because it contains a high level of glucose which comes from the Tigernuts during the cooking, this is the best stock to help the fermentation process. We introduce them into a hermetic container where we will leave them to settle between 3 and 5 days.



Raw particles should not be used without a proper previous preparation. Non cooked particles can be very harmful for carp as they can not digest them properly.



(6) During these days, the liquid will convert into a viscous gel which is delicious for the carp
